

Materials Needed:

Yarn in your choice of colors I/9 crochet hook Scissors



Tapestry needle

Granny Square Blanket Pattern:

Round 1: Chain 3 with your first color.

Work 2 double crochets into the first chain, chain 1.

Work a double crochet cluster into the same stitch, chain 1 – repeat * 3 times.

Slip stitch to the top of the beginning chain. You'll have four double crochet clusters and 4 chain-1 spaces at the end of this round.

Round 2: Slip stitch in the next two stitches and into the chain-1 space.

Chain 2, work 2 double crochets into the same chain-1 space, chain 1.

Work a double crochet cluster into the same chain-1 space.

Work a double crochet cluster, chain 1, double crochet cluster in the next chain-1 space – repeat * around.

Slip stitch to the top of the first chain-2. You should have 8 double crochet clusters and 4 chain-1 spaces at the end of this round.

Round 3: Slip stitch in the next two stitches and into the chain-1 space.

Chain 2, work 2 double crochets into the same chain-1 space, chain 1.

Work a double crochet cluster into the same chain-1 space.

Work a double crochet cluster into the space between the clusters from the previous round.

Work a double crochet cluster, chain 1, double crochet cluster in the next chain-1 space. Work a double crochet cluster into the space between the clusters from the previous round – repeat * around.

Slip stitch to the top of the first chain-2. You should have 12 double crochet clusters and 4 chain-1 spaces at the end of this round.

Continue in the same manner for the remaining rounds of the granny square pattern. Work two double crochet clusters into each corner with a chain 1 in between them. Work 1 double crochet cluster into each space between the clusters in the previous round.

When changing colors, cut the yarn and weave in the ends. Join the next color in any of the chain-1 spaces and continue the pattern.





Granny Square Border Pattern:

Round 1: Work half double crochets around the entire blanket, working 3 half double crochets into each corner stitch.

Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.

Round 2: Join white yarn using a slip stitch.

Single crochet in the next five stitches, chain 3, half double crochet in the first chain – repeat * around.

Adjust the stitches between picots to ensure there's one in each corner, but don't worry too



much about exact spacing; imperfections won't be noticeable once the blanket is finished. Enjoy the process of creating your beautiful Granny Square Blanket with its charming border!
