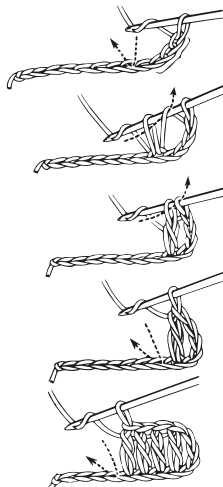

PATTERNS

Crochet Stitch Directory
Review the stitch tutorials to ensure your pieces
will come out perfect.

DOUBLE CROCHET (dc)

Yarn over, insert the hook in the 5th chain, yarn over and pull through the chain (3 loops on the hook), yarn over, pull through 2 loops, (2 loops remain on the hook), yarn over, pull through the last 2 loops. Continue to work one double crochet in each remaining chain across the hook.



CHAIN (ch)

Make a slip knot on the hook. Bring yarn over hook from back to front and grab it with hook. Repeat.



SLIP STITCH (sl st)

Insert hook, yarn over and draw yarn through chain and the loop on your hook in one motion.

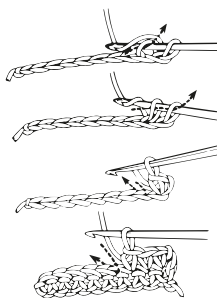


PICOT

Ch 3, insert hook in the third chain from the hook, yarn over and draw yarn through the loop on hook.

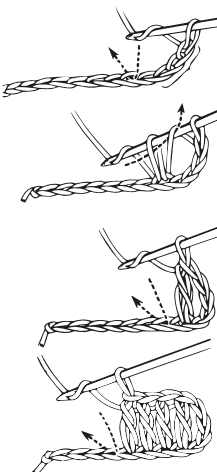
SINGLE CROCHET (sc)

Follow the same instruction to make slip stitch until you draw yarn through the chain stitch and up onto the hook. There are now 2 loops on hook. Bring yarn over hook from back to front and draw it through both loops.



HALF DOUBLE CROCHET (hdc)

Insert hook on the 3rd chain on the left. Bring yarn over and draw it through the chain stitch and up. You now have 3 loops on the hook. Draw yarn through all 3 loops in one motion. Continue to work one half double crochet in each remaining chain across the hook.



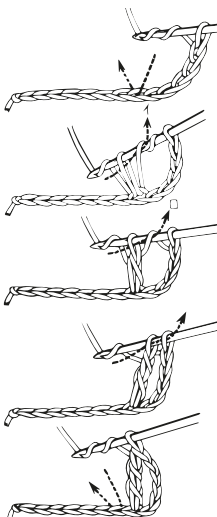
INCREASE (inc)

To increase, make 2 sc into every single stitch.



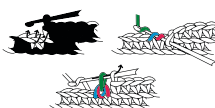
TREBLE CROCHET (trc)

Yarn over twice, insert hook into the 6th chain, yarn over and pull through (4 loops on the hook), yarn over and pull through 2 loops, yarn over and pull through 2 loops. You have now 1 loop on the hook. Continue to work one treble crochet in each remaining chain across the hook.



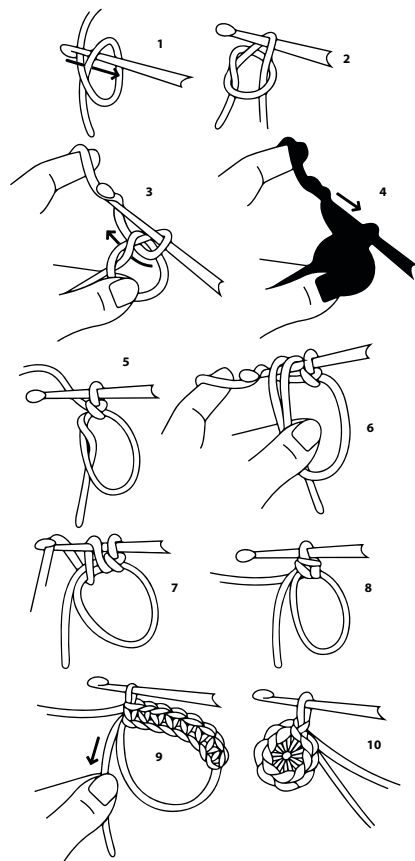
DECREASE (dec)

Insert hook into the front loop on the first stitch and do the same on the second stitch. You have 2 loops on the hook, yarn over, pull through and now you have 2 loops, yarn over and pull through the remaining 2 loops.



MAGIC RING

Loop the yarn around your fingers. Insert hook into the loop and draw up a loop loosely. Hold this loop with your thumb and middle finger and wrap the yarn on your index finger. Make a chain stitch and now you are crocheting over the loop and the yarn tail. Draw up a loop and begin your first sc. Continue to crochet over the loop and the yarn tail until you have the required number of sc mentioned in the pattern. Pull the tail yarn to close the ring.





MIDI DRESS

6 balls of Anne - color 3526
 Circulo crochet hook No 0/1.75 mm
 Tapestry needle
 Fabric to line dress
 Paper; Pencil; Scissors

Crochet stitch glossary and abbreviations:

stitch: st, stitches: sts; repeat: rep
 chain: ch, slip stitch: sl st, single crochet (sc), double crochet (dc),
 2 double crochet cluster (2 dc cluster): 2 dc closed together in the
 same base stitch, dc2tog: 2 dc closed together in different base sts,
 dc6tog: 6 dc together closed in different base sts,
 Pattern A - Chart 1

Gauge: 27 dc x 10 R = 4"/10 cm using crochet hook No 0/1.75mm

Transfer measurement chart to paper to guide along work. Arrows indicate direction

Dress - Part 1 (top) Back: Use Anne and crochet hook No 0/1.75mm. Start from the neckline. Row 1: ch 3, 1 dc rep to 32x more. Into top part of this cord, follow Pattern A - Chart 1, repeat sts and motifs per tier chart. Work back and forth. When piece measures 17.5"/44 cm fasten off and set aside.

Right front: Use Anne and crochet hook No 0/1.75mm. Start from shoulder. Row 1: ch 3, 1 dc repe to 11x more. Into top part of this cord follow Pattern A - Chart 1, repeat sts and motifs per tier chart. Work back and forth. When piece measures 17.5"/44 cm, fasten off and set aside.

Left front: Make the same as right front. Part 2 (top assembly) - sew right and left front onto back through lower sides (7"/18 cm). On the top front, pinch together until it gets to 2.75"/7cm. Cross right and left front as shown on picture and sew sides. Sew pinched parts 2.75"/7cm on the top, forming shoulders. Armholes size: 10.25"/26 cm. Part 3 - Skirt. Back and front are worked together, crochet in the rounds. Make 4 sc rows, closing them with a sl st. Part 4: Follow Pattern B - chart 2, repeat sts and also motifs per tier chart. Crochet in the round and finish rows as shown in the chart. Part 5: Rows 1 - 14: Follow Pattern C chart 3 + repeat sts, crochet in the rounds and close rows with a sl st. End garment with a crochet edge - Pattern D - chart 4 and repeat sts. Armhole and neckline finishings: Follow Pattern D - chart 4 and repeat sts around armholes and neckline. Use measurement chart to line your dress and sew around armholes and neckline.



DRESS WITH MINI CAPE

5 balls of Circulo Clea 5 - color 3182
 Circulo crochet hook No 2/1.5mm
 Tapestry needle
 12"/30 cm zipper
 Fabric to line dress
 2 cups
 1 medium pearl button
 Paper; Pencil; Scissors

Transfer measurement chart to paper to guide along work. Arrows indicate direction.

Dress (Upper part) - Front and back are worked together. Use Clea 5 and crochet hook No 2/1.5mm. Start from waistline with a foundation chain represented in blue in Pattern A. Row 1: ch 3, 1 dc rep from to 56x more. Into foundation chain, follow Chart 1, repeat sts and measurement chart. Work back and forth. When piece measures 12", fasten off. Fold piece in half to determine back and front, leaving a 12" opening on the right side. Dress (bottom part) - Join yarn into foundation chain represented in blue in the chart and follow Pattern B - chart 2, repeat sts and measurement chart. When piece measures 21.75", start following Pattern C - Chart 3 from rows 1 - 8. Crochet in the rounds, closing rows with a sl st. Fasten off. Crochet edge - chart 4: work around neckline and side opening (12"). Sew zipper inside opening. Use measurement chart to line your dress and sew around neckline and sides. On the WS sew cups.

Cape: Use Clea 5 and hook No 2/1.5mm and start from neckline. Row 1: ch 3, 1 dc rep 56x more. Row 2: follow chart 5, repeat sts and measurement chart. When piece measures 10", follow Pattern E - Chart 6 and rep sts from rows 1 - 8. Work back and forth. Crochet edge - chart 4: work around neckline and sides. on the RS edge, sew button.



LONG SLEEVE DRESS

 Circulo tapestry needle

 1 pearl button (0.45")
 Fabric to line dress
 Paper; Pencil; Scissors.

Crochet stitch glossary and abbreviations:

stitch: st, stitches: sts; repeat: rep
 chain: ch, slip stitch: sl st, single crochet (sc), double crochet (dc)
 Pattern A - Chart 1
 Pattern B - Chart 2

Gauge: 20 dc x 10 rows = 4"/10 cm using crochet hook D3/3.25mm

Transfer measurement chart to paper to guide along work. Arrows indicate direction.

Dress (front - upper part) Start from shoulder line. Use crochet hook D3/3.25mm and Fashion. Right side: ch 17 and into this foundation ch follow Pattern A - chart 1, repeat sts for 3.25", fasten off and set aside. Follow same directions for left side. Join both pieces (3.25" x 3.25") with a chain. Ch 42 (neckline). Follow Pattern A - chart 1, repeat sts. Work back and forth. When piece measures 20" fasten off and set aside.

Dress (back - Upper part) Start from shoulder line. Use crochet hook D3/3.25mm and Fashion. Right side: ch 38 and into this foundation ch follow Pattern A - Chart 1, repeat sts for 4". Fasten off and set aside. Follow same directions for left side. Continue following Pattern A - chart , repeat sts. Work back and forth. When piece measures 20" fasten off and set aside.

Upper part assembly: Use tapestry needle and Fashion to sew both parts: front & back through sides (13") left and (6") right side, leaving armhole openings (7") and side opening (7") for zipper. Join shoulders (3.25"). Crochet edge: around neckline. Use crochet hook D3/3.25mm and work first row of Pattern A - Chart 1, repeat sts around neckline and back opening.

Dress (bottom part - skirt) Back and front are worked together. Use crochet hook D3/3.25mm and Fashion. Join waistline from Upper part and follow Pattern B - Chart 2, repeat sts from rows 1 - 85. Crochet in the round and close every row with a sl st. Ps.:When working on Pattern B, follow the amount of chains between sts starting in row 7. Fasten off and set aside. Sleeves: Use crochet hook D3/3.25mm and Fashion and start from the top. Ch 59 and into this foundation ch follow Pattern A - chart 1, repeat sts and work back and forth. When sleeve measures 20.5" fasten off and make another.



FLARE DRESS

15 balls of Circulo Clea 1000 color 8001
 1 Circulo crochet hook No 4/1.25 mm
 Circulo Tapestry needle
 Fabric to line dress
 Paper; pencil; scissors.

Crochet stitch glossary and abbreviations:

stitch: st, stitches: sts; repeat: rep
 chain: ch, slip stitch: sl st, single crochet (sc), double crochet (dc),
 2 double crochet cluster (2 dc cluster): 2 dc closed together in the same base stitch, sc + 2dc cluster: sc as base with 2 dc closed on top; dc2tog: 2 dc closed together in different base sts; dc3tog: 3 dc closed together in different base sts;
 Pattern A - Chart 1
 Crochet edge A - Chart 2
 Square - Chart 3
 Half square - Chart 4
 Crochet edge B - Chart 5
 Twisted cord - follow illustration.

Gauge: 5.11" x 5.11" over square chart 3

Transfer measurement chart to paper to guide along work. Arrows indicate direction.

Square - Use Clea and hook No 4/1.25 mm and ch 5, 1 sl st. Row 1: ch 1, 1 sc, ch 4, 1 dc into 3rd chain from hook, ch 9, 2 dc cluster into previous sc, ch 3, sc base with 2 dc cluster on top, ch 3, sc base with 2 dc cluster on top, ch 9, sc base with 2 dc cluster on top, rep to 2x more, ch 3, sc base with 2 dc cluster on top, ch 9, sc base with 2 dc cluster on top, rep to 1x. Rows 2 - 5: follow Chart 3. Crochet in rounds and close with sl st.

Half-square: Use Clea and crochet hook No 4/1.25 mm. Ch 5, 1 sl st to close. Row 1: ch1, 1 sc, ch 4, 1 dc into the third ch from hook, ch 9, 2 dc cluster into previous sc, ch 3, sc base with 2 dc cluster on top, ch 3, sc base with 2 dc cluster on top, ch 9, sc base with 2 dc cluster on top, rep to 1x. Rows 2 - 5: follow Chart 4. Work back and forth.

Dress - (upper part) - Start above bust (each cup). Use Clea and crochet hook No 4/1.25mm and start right cup: ch 9 and into this foundation chain follow Chart 1, rep sts. when cup measures 4", fasten off and set aside. Left cup: follow same instructions until cup measures 4". Join cups in center and follow Pattern A - Chart 1, rep sts and assembly chart to form front & back. when piece measures 15.75" fasten off.

Follow Pattern A - Chart 2, rep sts and crochet edges around piece. Work back and forth. Set aside. Dress - skirt - Make 386 squares and 20 half squares, joining them with a sl st. Join first squares to form front (166 squares + 10 half squares), join A with A and B with B. Find the center and sew upper part using tapestry needle. Now work on back, join 220 squares + 10 half squares. Join C with C and D with D. At the bottom follow Crochet edge B - Chart 5, rep sts. Crochet in the round and close with a sl st.

end of row 5 and beginning of row 6, follow Pattern B - chart 2 (rows 5 & 6) Into row 6, follow chart 5 and make crochet borders. Fasten off.

Part 3: Join front & back sides with sl sts. Use crochet hook No 0/1.75 mm and Anne to start skirt. Follow Pattern B c chart 2, rep sts and the amount of motifs per row. Rows 10 - 22: crochet in the round.

Part 4 - Dress train: On the back, follow Pattern A - chart 1, rep sts and the amount of motifs per row. Rows 23 - 28: Work back and forth, fasten off. Straps: Use crochet hook No 0/1.75 mm and follow Pattern D. Ch 71, rows 1 - 12: follow chart 4. Work back and forth. Fasten off. Make another one. Sew them on back top, into shoulder front line as shown on measurement chart.

Zipper: Make 2 sc rows into upper left side to sew zipper. Use tapestry needle to sew it. Use measurement chart to line your dress, sew around neckline, front and back and also armholes..

chain: ch, slip stitch: sl st, single crochet (sc), half double crochet (hdc), double crochet (dc), front post double crochet (fpdc) dc from front to back between the posts of dc from the row below, 3 double crochet closed together (dc3tog): 3 dc closed together in different base sts,

Pattern A - Chart 1

Pattern B - Chart 2

Pattern C - Chart 3

Pattern D - Chart 4

Crochet edge - Chart 5

Straps - Chart 6

Gauge: 27 dc x 12 rows = 4"/10 cm using crochet hook No 2/1.5mm

Transfer measurement chart to paper to guide along work. Arrows indicate direction.

Dress Part 1 - Front: Start from neckline. Use crochet hook No 2/1.5mm and Clea 5 and ch 34, into this foundation chain follow Pattern A - Chart 1 from row 1 - 13. Work back and forth. Fasten off and set aside.

Back: Same as front. Part 2 - Join front & back with sl sts and then crochet in the round following chart instructions. Follow Pattern B - Chart 2, rep sts and the illustration about amount of motifs per columns. In this part, 10 tiers with 7 motifs. Part 3 - Rows 1 - 6, follow Pattern C - chart 3, rep sts. Part 4 - Switch to Pattern B, work 10 columns with 8 motifs and 12 columns with 7 motifs. Part 5 - Rows 1 - 11: follow Pattern D - chart 4, rep sts. After finishing Part 4 and Part 5, follow Pattern B - chart 2 (rows 5 & 6). Into row 6, Make a crochet

border - chart 5, rep sts.

Part 6 - Follow Pattern B and work 12 columns with 9 motifs, 16 columns with 14 motifs and 16 columns with 33 motifs. Follow Chart 5, rep sts and finish piece with crochet edges. After finishing this part, between the end of row 5 and beginning of row 6, follow Pattern B - chart 2 (rows 5 & 6) Into row 6, follow chart 5 and make crochet borders. Fasten off.

Straps - Join front & back with a cord with 30 chains. Into this foundation chain and around neckline make 2 sc rows. Also into the same foundation chain and armholes, make 2 sc rows. Crochet in the round and close every row with a sl st. Use measurement chart to line your dress, sew around neckline and armholes.



3/4 SLEEVE DRESS

6 balls of Circulo Anne - color 6313

1 Circulo crochet hook No 0/1.75mm

1 Circulo Tapestry needle

1 Zipper 8"/20 cm long

Fabric to line dress

2 buttons

Paper, Pencil and scissors.

Crochet stitch glossary and abbreviations:

stitch: st, stitches: sts; repeat: rep

chain: ch, slip stitch: sl st, single crochet (sc), half double crochet (hdc), double crochet (dc), treble crochet (tr), picot

Pattern A - Chart 1

Pattern B - Chart 2

Crochet edge C - Chart 3

Crochet edge E - Chart 5

Neckline front & back edge - Chart 6

Crochet edge F - chart 7

Gauge: 27 dc x 12 rows = 4"/10 cm using crochet hook No 0/1.75mm.

Transfer measurement chart to paper to guide along work. Arrows indicate direction.

Dress - upper part - Front & back are worked all together. Use crochet hook No 0/1.75mm and Anne and start piece under bust. Start with a cord at the center of back. Ch 216 and follow Pattern A - chart 1, rep sts and measurement chart. When piece measures 2" start opening on the back. When piece measures 6" work front & back separately. Fasten off according chart.

Start front neckline when piece measures 11", follow the beginning of chart 1. When piece measures 13.75" fasten off. Dress - bottom part - Join Anne into back center foundation chain and follow Pattern B - chart 2, rep sts (rows 1 - 92). Rows 1 - 15 work back and forth and after crochet in rounds, closing with sl st. Finish piece with crochet edge C - Chart 3, rep sts from rows 93 - 95. Work in rounds and end rows according to chart. Fasten off and set aside.

Assembly, finishings and sleeves - Use tapestry needle and sew shoulders. Switch to crochet hook No 2/1.50mm and use Anne to

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Twisted cords: Make 4 cords (45.25 " each). Sew 2 cords on the top of each cup and cross them on back, as shown on chart. Use measurement chart to line your dress until ankles. Sew it around neckline (front & back) and around armholes.

 3, 1 sl st to close. Row 2: follow chart 1. Crochet in the round.

Vertical Strip B - Use crochet hook No 0/1.75 mm and Anne. Row 1:
 ch 10, 1 tr. Rows 2 - 65: follow chart 3. Work back and forth. Make 3
 more and set them aside.

Dress - Front upper part - Make 2 vertical strips with 6 roses joined
 with sl st. In the inner part make vertical strips A - chart 2, rep sts. In
 the external part, follow chart 4, rep sts and the assembly chart. Work
 back and forth. When strip measures 13" fasten off and set aside.
 Dress - Back upper part - Use crochet hook No 0/1.75 mm and Anne
 and make a 12.5" cord and into this foundation chain follow Pattern -
 chart 4, rep sts. Work back and forth. When piece measures 13" fasten
 off and set aside.

Dress (bottom part - skirt) make 4 vertical strips with 10 roses each,
 4 vertical strips B. Join roses and vertical strips B with Vertical strips A
 and join them into waistline with sl st. On the back, below waistline,
 make 2 dc rows to sew zipper between them. Hem: Make 1 horizontal
 strip with 29 roses, make 1 horizontal strip above and below this strip,
 following Strip A. Fasten off and set aside.

Sleeves (upper part) - Make 2 strips with 4 roses each, to join them
 make Strip A in between. Make the round part of sleeve following
 Pattern A - chart 4, rep sts. Work back and forth. Sleeves (bottom) -
 Rows 1 - 14: Follow chart 5. Crochet in the round and close every row
 with a sl st. Make 2 sleeves and set aside.

Assembly and finishings: Use tapestry needle and Anne and sew
 shoulders (3.25"). Sew sleeves. On top of back, sew buttons. Below
 waistline, sew zipper. Crochet edges: Use Anne and crochet hook No

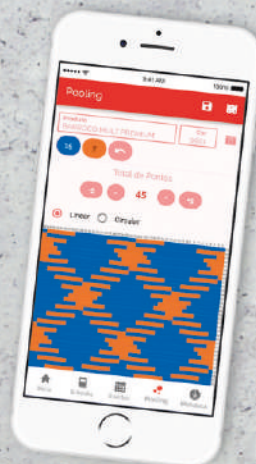
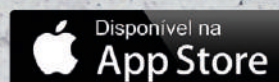
