

Floral Granny Square - Step-by-Step Tutorial

Materials Needed

- Worsted weight yarn (two colors: beige and blue)
- 4.0 mm crochet hook
- Yarn needle and scissors
- Optional: small pearl bead for center

Stitches Used

- ch: chain
- dc: double crochet
- tr: treble crochet
- sl st: slip stitch

Pattern Instructions

1. Start with beige yarn. Make a magic ring.
2. Round 1: ch 3 (counts as dc), work 15 dc into the ring, sl st to join. (16 sts)
3. Round 2 (blue): ch 3, *skip 1 st, 3 dc in next st*, repeat around, sl st to join.
4. Round 3 (beige): In space between clusters, work *2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc* to form petals.
5. Round 4 (blue): tr in center of each petal, repeat around.
6. Final Round (beige): ch 3, dc around forming corners with (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc).

Finishing

- Fasten off and weave in all ends neatly.
- Sew a pearl bead in the center if desired.
- Block your square for best shape.



FLORAL GRANNY SQUARE - BEGINNER GUIDE



STITCH KEY (SYMBOL GUIDE):

○ ch (chain): Yarn over, pull through loop. Used to form foundation or space.

x sc (single crochet): Insert hook, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through both

T dc (double crochet): Yarn over, insert, yarn over, pull through, yarn over pull through

7 tr (treble crochet): Yarn over twice, insert, pull through, yarn over pull through 2 (3 ti

sl slip stitch: Insert hook, yarn over, pull through both loops. Used to join.

INSTRUCTIONS (Step-by-Step for Beginners):

ROUND 1:

Start with a magic ring. Work 12 dc into the ring. Join with sl st to the first dc.

ROUND 2:

Ch 3, (acts as dc). In same st, dc, ch 1, 2 dc in next st, repeat around. Join with sl st.
