

## Free Granny Square pattern collection

### Granny Doris crochet granny square pattern



You will need:

- A 4mm or US G/6 hook
- Any DK cotton yarn, 1 ball of each:
  - **Yarn A** Claret Red
  - **Yarn B** Yellow
  - **Yarn C** Aubergine
  - **Yarn D** Light Blue
  - **Yarn E** Peacock Blue

Notes

All patterns are written in UK terminology.

Granny Doris Pattern

With Yarn A, ch4, join with a ss into a ring.

**Round 1** Ch3 (counts as tr), 11tr into ring, ss to top of beg ch-3, fasten off.


**Round 2** Join Yarn B in any st with a ss. Ch3 (counts as tr), 1tr into back loop of same st, \*(1tr into front loop, 1tr into back loop) of same st; rep from \* 10 times, ss to top of beg ch-3, fasten off.

**Round 3** Join Yarn C in any st with a ss. Ch3 (counts as tr), (1tr, ch2, 2tr) into same st, \*1tr into each of next 5 tr, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) into next tr to form corner; rep from \* twice, 1tr into each of next 5 tr, ss to top of beg ch-3, fasten off.

**Round 4** Join Yarn D in any corner ch-2 sp with a ss. Ch3 (counts as tr), (1tr, ch2, 2tr) into same sp, \*1tr into each of next 9 tr, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) into next ch-sp to form corner; rep from \* twice, 1tr into each of next 9 tr, ss to top of beg ch-3, fasten off.

**Round 5** Join Yarn E in a corner ch-sp with a ss. Ch1 (does not count as st), dc evenly around with 1dc in each st and 2dc in each ch-2 sp, fasten off.

Weave in all ends.



## Granny Doreen crochet granny square pattern



You will need:

- A 4mm or US G/6 hook
- Any DK cotton yarn, 1 ball of each:
  - **Yarn A** Green
  - **Yarn B** Navy
  - **Yarn C** Light Orange
  - **Yarn D** Grey Brown

### Special abbreviations

**3-tr cluster:** (Yrh, insert hook in space/st indicated, yrh and pull up loop, yrh and draw through 2 loops) 3 times, inserting the hook in the same space/st each time, yrh and draw through all loops on hook.

**4-tr cluster:** (Yrh, insert hook in space/st indicated, yrh and pull up loop, yrh and draw through 2 loops) 4 times, inserting the hook in the same space/st each time, yrh and draw through all loops on hook.

### Granny Doreen Pattern

With Yarn A, ch8, join with a ss into a ring.


**Round 1** Ch3 (counts as tr), 3-tr cluster into ring, \*ch4, 4-tr cluster into ring; rep from \* twice, ch4, ss to top of 3-tr cluster, fasten off.

**Round 2** Join Yarn B in any ch-4 corner sp with a ss. Ch3 (counts as tr), (2tr, ch3, 3tr) in same corner sp, \*tr into top of next cluster, (3tr, ch3, 3tr) in next corner sp; rep from \* twice, ss to top of beg ch-3, fasten off.

**Round 3** Join Yarn C in any ch-3 corner sp with a ss. Ch3 (counts as tr), (1tr, ch3, 2tr) in same ch-3 corner sp, \*1tr in each of next 7 tr, (2tr, ch3, 2tr) in next ch-3 corner sp; rep from \* twice, 1tr in each of next 7 tr, ss to top of beg ch-3, fasten off.

**Round 4** Join Yarn D in a corner ch-sp with a ss. Ch1 (does not count as a st), dc in each st around working 2dc in each corner ch-sp, ss to first dc, fasten off.

Weave in all ends.



## Granny Florence crochet granny square pattern



You will need:

- A 4mm or US G/6 hook
- Any DK cotton yarn, 1 ball of each:
  - **Yarn A** Light Green
  - **Yarn B** Bright Pink
  - **Yarn C** Pink
  - **Yarn D** Navy

## Granny Florence Pattern

With Yarn A, ch6, join with a ss into a ring.


**Round 1** Ch3 (counts as tr), 2tr into ring, ch3, (3tr into ring, ch3) three times, ss to top of beg ch-3, fasten off.

**Round 2** Join Yarn B in any corner ch-3 sp with a ss. Ch3 (counts as tr), (2tr, ch1, 3tr) into same ch-3 sp, ch2, \*(3tr, ch1, 3tr) into next ch-3 sp, ch2; rep from \* twice, ss to top of beg ch-3, fasten off.

**Round 3** Join Yarn C in any corner ch-1 sp with a ss. Ch3 (counts as tr), (2tr, ch1, 3tr) into same sp, \*ch2, (tr, ch2, tr) into next ch-2 sp, ch2, (3tr, ch1, 3tr) into next ch-1 sp; rep from \* twice, ch2, (tr, ch2, tr) into next ch-2 sp, ch2, ss to top of beg ch-3, fasten off.

**Round 4** Join Yarn D in any corner ch-1 sp with a ss. Ch3 (counts as tr), (2tr, ch1, 3tr) into same sp, \*ch3, skip next ch-2 sp, (tr, ch3, tr) into next ch-2 sp, ch3, skip next ch-2 sp, (3tr, ch1, 3tr) into next ch-1 sp; rep from \* twice, ch3, skip next ch-2 sp, (tr, ch3, tr) into next ch-2 sp, ch3, ss to top of beg ch-3, fasten off.

Weave in all ends.



## Granny Audrey crochet granny square pattern



## You will need:

- A 4mm or US G/6 hook
- Any DK cotton yarn, 1 ball of each:
  - **Yarn A** Light Orange
  - **Yarn B** Grey Brown
  - **Yarn C** Light Green
  - **Yarn D** Fuchsia

## Granny Audrey Pattern

With Yarn A, ch6, join with a ss into a ring.


**Round 1** Ch6 (counts as 1tr, ch3), (1tr into ring, ch3) 7 times, ss to top of beg ch-3, fasten off.

**Round 2** Join Yarn B in any ch-3 sp with a ss. Ch3 (counts as tr), 3tr in same ch-3 sp, ch2, (4tr into next ch-3 sp, ch2) 7 times, ss to top of beg ch-3, fasten off.

**Round 3** Join Yarn C in any ch-2 sp with a ss. Ch5 (counts as 1tr, ch2), (6tr into next ch-2 sp, ch2) 7 times, 5tr into next ch-2 sp, ss to top of beg ch-3, fasten off.

**Round 4** Join Yarn D in any ch-2 sp with a ss. Ch1 (does not count as dc), dc in same ch-2 sp, \*ch3, dc in centre of 6tr group (in sp between 3rd and 4th tr), ch3, dc in next ch-2 sp, ch3, (2tr, ch3, 2tr) in centre of next 6tr group (in sp between 3rd and 4th tr), ch3, dc in next ch-2 sp; rep from \* twice, ch3, dc in centre of 6tr group (in sp between 3rd and 4th tr), ch3, dc in next ch-2 sp, ch3, (2tr, ch3, 2tr) in centre of next 6tr group (in sp between 3rd and 4th tr), ch3, ss to first dc, fasten off.

Weave in all ends.



## Granny Irene crochet granny square pattern



## You will need

- DK yarn in 5 shades
- A 4mm (US G/6) hook

## Granny Irene pattern

Using **Yarn A**, ch6, ss to first ch to join into a ring.

**Round 1 (RS)** Ch3 (counts as tr throughout), 3tr into ring, ch3, (4tr into ring, ch3) 3 times, ss to top of beg ch-3. [16 sts, 4 ch-sps] **Fasten off.**


**Round 2** Join **Yarn B** in top of beg ch-3 with a ss, ch5 (counts as tr and ch2 throughout), skip 2 tr, tr in next tr, \*(2tr, ch3, 2tr) in next ch-sp, tr in next tr, ch2, skip 2 tr, tr in next tr, rep from \* twice more, (2tr, ch3, 2tr) in next ch-sp, ss to top of beg ch-3. [24 sts, 8 ch-sps] **Fasten off.**

**Round 3** Join **Yarn C** in top of beg ch-3 with a ss, ch5, \*tr in each of next 3 tr, (2tr, ch3, 2tr) in ch-3 corner sp, tr in next 3 tr, ch2, rep from \* twice more, tr in each of next 3 tr, (2tr, ch3, 2tr) in ch-3 corner sp, tr in each of next 2 tr, ss to top of beg ch-3. [40 sts, 8 ch-sps] **Fasten off.**

**Round 4** Join **Yarn D** in top of beg ch-3 with a ss, ch5, \*tr in next 5 tr, (2tr, ch3, 2tr) in ch-3 corner sp, tr in each of next 5 tr, ch2, rep from \* twice more, tr in each of next 5 tr, (2tr, ch3, 2tr) in ch-3 corner sp, tr in each of next 4 tr, ss to top of beg ch-3. [56 sts, 8 ch-sps] **Fasten off.**

**Round 5** Join Yarn E in top of beg ch-3 with a ss, ch3, tr in each st around, working 2tr in each ch-2 sp and 3 tr in each ch-3 sp. Ss to top of beg ch-3. [76 sts]

**Fasten off and weave in ends.**



## Granny Mabel crochet granny square pattern



## You will need:

- DK in 6 shades
- A 4mm (US G/6) hook

## Granny Mabel pattern

Using Yarn A, ch6, ss to first ch to join into a ring.

**Round 1 (RS)** Ch3 (counts as tr throughout), 2tr into ring, ch2, (3tr into ring, ch2) 3 times, ss to top of beg ch-3. [12 sts, 4 ch-sps] **Fasten off.**

**Round 2** Join Yarn B in any corner ch-2 sp with a ss. Ch3, (2tr, ch2, 3tr) into same ch-2 sp, \*ch2, (3tr, ch2, 3tr) into next ch-2 sp, rep from \* twice more, ch2, ss to top of beg ch-3. [32 sts, 8 ch-sps] **Fasten off.**

**Round 3** Join Yarn C in any corner ch-2 sp with a ss. Ch3, (2tr, ch2, 3tr) into same ch-2 sp, \*tr in next 3 tr, 2tr in next ch-2 sp, tr in next 3 tr, (3tr, ch2, 3tr) into corner ch-2 sp, rep from \* twice more, tr in each of next 3 tr, 2tr in next ch-2 sp, tr in each of next 3 tr, ss to top of beg ch-3. [56 sts, 4 ch-sps] **Fasten off.**

**Round 4** Join Yarn D in any corner ch-2 sp with a ss. Ch3, (2tr, ch2, 3tr) into same ch-2 sp, \*skip next 3 tr, 3tr in next tr, skip next 2 tr, 3tr in next tr, skip next 3 tr, 3tr in next tr, (3tr, ch2, 3tr) into next ch-2 sp, rep from \* twice more, skip next 3 tr, 3tr in next tr, skip next 2 tr, 3tr in next tr, skip next 3 tr, 3tr in next tr, ss to top of beg ch-3. [60 sts, 4 ch-sps] **Fasten off.**

**Round 5** Join Yarn E in any corner ch-2 sp with a ss. Ch3, (tr, ch2, 2tr) into same ch-2 sp, \*tr in each of next 15 tr, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) into next ch-2 sp, rep from \* twice more, tr in each of next 15 tr, ss to top of beg ch-3. [76 sts, 4 ch-sps] **Fasten off.**

**Round 6** Join Yarn F in any corner ch-2 sp with a ss. Ch1 (does not count as st), dc in each stitch around, working 2dc in each corner ch-2 sp, ss to first dc. [84 sts] **Fasten off** and weave in ends.
