Birds in Spring - Crochet Pattern

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Assembly Instructions

Design: Suzanne Thérèse
Materials:
- 280g of cotton thread No. 10, white
- 30g of golden thread
- Steel crochet hook No. 1.50 mm
- A metal frame for an 8-rib umbrella
Gauge (Sample):
The first 4 rounds = 35 cm in diameter
Instructions
1st Round:
Make 12 ch and close with a slip stitch to form a ring. Crochet 12 sc and close with a sl st.
Note: Pin on the center of the ring.
Before continuing, make sure the upper end of the frame shaft fits through the center hole.
Panels:
Work 8 panels separately and sew each one to the umbrella frame. Adapt their final shape to the required
diameter.
To begin:
Work the motifs as indicated in the diagrams 1 to 4. For all rows, work dc and ch as shown.
Join each round as indicated and finish off each row with a slip stitch into the top of the previous dc.

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Joining Panels:

Sew the motifs around the umbrella frame by hand. Insert the top end of the umbrella frame into the central ring. Pull the work tight to fix the lower ends of each panel to the 8 ribs.

Golden Border:

Around the central heart motif of each panel, work a round of sc with golden thread.

Finishing:

Insert the umbrella rod into the central opening of the piece. Pull tightly to secure the motifs around the frame evenly. Adjust and secure with golden thread as indicated.

Notes:

- Follow diagrams from 1 to 4.
- The measurements are approximate and may vary slightly depending on the tension.
