## MATERIALS & ABBREVIATIONS

### Materials

- Fine Acrylic Yarn (any color)
- Hook: 2.5 mm
- Other:  
Needle, stitch markers, scissors,  
pins
- Glue

### Abbreviations

R: Round	Sk: Skip crochet
MR: Magic ring	Hdc: Half double
Sl st/ SL, Slip stitch	Dc: Double crochet
Ch Chain	Inc: Increase 2 sc in same st
St/Sts, stitch	Dec: Decrease 2 sc
Sc Single crochete	Tr: Treble crochet
Hdc: Half double crochet	Tr: Treble crochet
Tr Treble crochet	Sk: Skip stitch ( )x.n

# Flower Curtain Pattern

## Materials & Abbreviations

- Yarn: Fine Acrylic Yarn (in various colors of your choice)
- Hook: 2.5 mm crochet hook
- Other: Needle, stitch markers, scissors, pins, glue

Abbreviations:

R: Round

MR: Magic Ring

Slst / SL: Slip Stitch

Ch: Chain

St / Sts: Stitch / Stitches

Sc: Single Crochet

Hdc: Half Double Crochet

Dc: Double Crochet

Tr: Treble Crochet

Inc: Increase (2 stitches in same stitch)

Dec: Decrease (2 stitches together)

BLO: Back Loop Only

FLO: Front Loop Only

BO: Bobble Stitch

( ) x n: Repeat instructions inside brackets n times

# Flower Curtain Pattern

## Flower Curtain Instructions

### BIG FLOWER:

Start with yellow yarn:

R1: MR: (dc, ch) x 8

Change to white yarn:

R2: In each ch-1 space from R1: (BO, ch2) x 8

Change to purple or red yarn:

R3: In each ch2 space from R2: (dc, 5tr, dc) x 8

Fasten off and cut yarn.

### SMALL FLOWER:

Start with purple or yellow yarn:

R1: MR: (dc, ch) x 8

Change to white yarn:

R2: In each ch-1 space from R1: (BO, ch2) x 8

Change to pink or white yarn:

R3: In each ch2 space from R2: (hdc, 5dc, hdc) x 8

Fasten off and cut yarn.

### LEAF (Green):

R1: Ch13, start from 2nd ch from hook

R2: sc, hdc, 2dc, 4tr, 2dc, hdc, 3sc in one st (W), then work back down the other side:

sc, hdc, 2dc, 4tr, 2dc, hdc, sc.

Fasten off and cut yarn.

### EXTRA FLOWERS:

#### FLOWER 1:

R1: MR 6sc

R2: 6inc (12)

R3: (sc, inc) x6 (18)

R4: (sc, inc, sc) x6 (24)

## Flower Curtain Pattern

R5: (3sc, inc) x6 (30) - Fasten off

FLOWER 2:

Same as Flower 1 until R3, then:

R4: (sc, hdc-inc, slst) x6 - Fasten off

FLOWER 3:

Same as Flower 1 until R4:

R5: [(sc, hdc) in same st, (hdc, slst) in same st] x9 - Fasten off

ASSEMBLY TIP:

Make as many flowers and leaves as you like. Use a long chain as the curtain string and sew or glue your motifs spaced evenly along it.

# Flower Curtain Pattern

## Rose Curtain Instructions

ROSE CURTAIN - Aisha Rose:

Make 6 Small Petals:

R1: MR 5sc, 1 slst, ch1

R2: 5inc, 1 slst, ch1 (10)

R3: (1sc, inc) x5, 1 slst, ch1 (15)

R4: (2sc, inc) x5, 1 slst, ch1 (20)

R5: (3sc, inc) x5, 1 slst, ch1 (25)

R6: (4sc, inc) x5, 1 slst, ch1 (30)

R7: 12sc, 5 hdc-inc, 13sc, slst, ch1 (35)

R8: 12sc, 10 dc-inc, 13sc, slst (45)

Make 5 Big Petals:

Repeat R1-R6 as above

R7: (5sc, inc) x5, 1 slst, ch1 (35)

R8: 6sc, (hdc-inc, 6hdc) x3, hdc-inc, 7sc, slst (39)

R9: ch3, 7dc, (3dc in same st) x25, 7dc, slst

Flower Sepals:

R1: MR 5sc, slst, ch1

R2: 5inc, slst, ch1

R3: 10sc, slst, ch1

R4: (1sc, inc) x5, slst, ch1

R5: (2sc, inc) x5, slst, ch1

R6: (3sc, inc) x5, slst

R7: (ch13, from 2nd ch: 3sc, 2hdc, 2dc, 2tr, 3dtr, skip 4st, slst) x5, slst, ch1

THAI ROSE:

Small Petal (Make 4):

R1: MR, ch3, 10dc, slst

R2: ch2, (2hdc in next st) x10, slst

R3: ch1, sc6, (2hdc in next st) x8, sc6, slst

Middle Petal (Make 4):

R1: MR, ch3, 10dc, slst

R2: ch2, (2hdc in next st) x10, slst

R3: ch1, sc2, (1sc, 2sc in next st) x8, sc2, slst

R4: ch1, sc9, (2hdc in next st) x10, sc9, slst

Big Petal (Make 5):

R1: MR, ch3, 10dc, slst

R2: ch2, (2hdc in next st) x10, slst

R3: ch2, (1hdc, 2hdc in next st) x10, slst

R4: ch1, sc8, (2hdc in next st) x6; (1hdc, 1dc); ch3; (1dc, 1hdc); (2hdc in next st) x6, sc8, slst, ch1

Rose Sepal:

R1: MR, ch1, 6sc, slst

R2: ch1, (2sc in next st) x6, slst

R3: ch1, (sc1, 2sc in next st) x6, slst

R4: ch1, 18sc, slst

R5: (ch9, from 2nd ch: slst2, 1sc, 2hdc, 2dc, 1tr, skip 2st, slst) x6, slst, ch1

LEAF:

Ch11, from 2nd ch: sc, hdc, 5dc, hdc, sc, (slst, ch, slst), sc, hdc, 5dc, hdc, sc.

ASSEMBLING THE ROSE:

1. Wrap and glue the small petals around a center rod.
2. Add middle petals around the small petals, overlapping slightly.
3. Add large petals to complete the rose.
4. Attach sepals at the base with hot glue.
5. Connect flowers with a chain string as shown.
